





The National Weather Service moved from legacy NWSChat to NWSChat 2.0, powered by Slack, on **August 1, 2023** to improve reliability, security, and expand functionality.

With Slack, you're now able to:

- Monitor weather alerts
- Contact internal & external folks in your communities, reliably
- Share out multimedia on desktop and mobile devices



Who is eligible to join NWSChat 2.0:

In order to participate in NWSChat, you must meet at least one of the following standards within the definition of NWS core partner:

- ✓ Be a member of the emergency management (EM) community
- ✓ Be a member of the water resources management community.
- ✓ Be a government partner of a NWS office.
- ✓ Be a member of the real-time media.





Start a thread




DO NOT THREAD during severe weather events!


